This quote includes district adopted Language Arts curriculum resources for reading, writing, and phonics, supplemental curriculum resources for reading and writing instruction, classroom libraries for kindergarten through fifth grade, materials and tools to assess student's reading skills, sets of leveled readers for the literacy library, and instructional resources to support small group and guided reading instruction.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Heinemann is currently awarded on the District's RFP# 2303-01 for Instructional Supplies, Software, Equipment & Services. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the 2023 bond authorization.

The approval of this purchase will allow the district to provide the needed instructional resources to teachers that will allow them to provide reading, writing and phonics instruction to all students in whole group and small group settings.
