2. Cooking or Baking (measurement, fractions, temperature)
3. Building (measurement, area and perimeter)
4. Shopping (counting, basic facts, fractions, percentages)
5. Yard work (Volume, area and perimeter, counting)
6. Crafts (patterning, measurements, basic facts, problem solving)
7. House work (patterning, basic facts counting)
8. Budgeting (counting, basic facts, problem solving)
9. Sewing, Crocheting and Knitting (patterning, problem solving, basic facts, measuring)
10. Driving (problem solving, science equations, measurement, time)

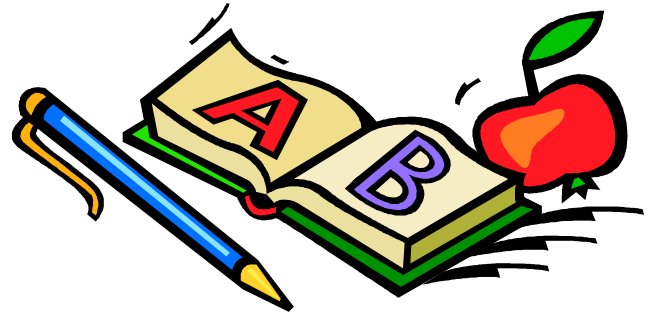
