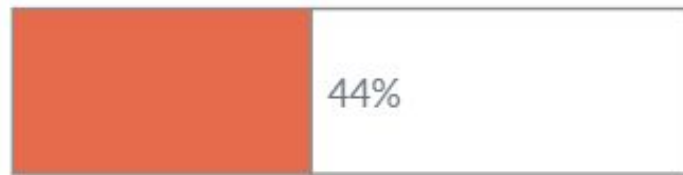
% of Students

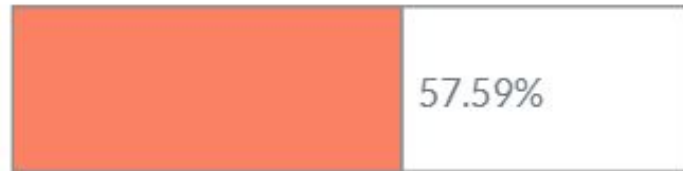
% of Students

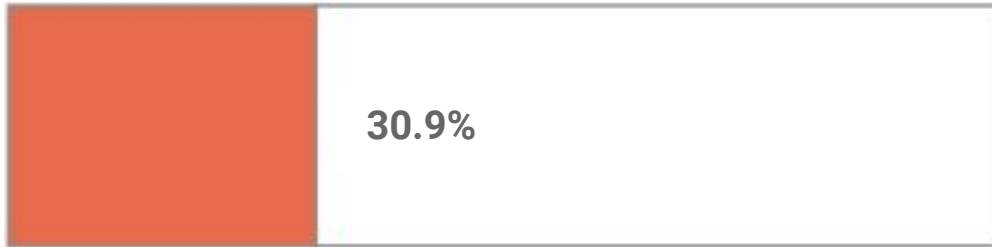

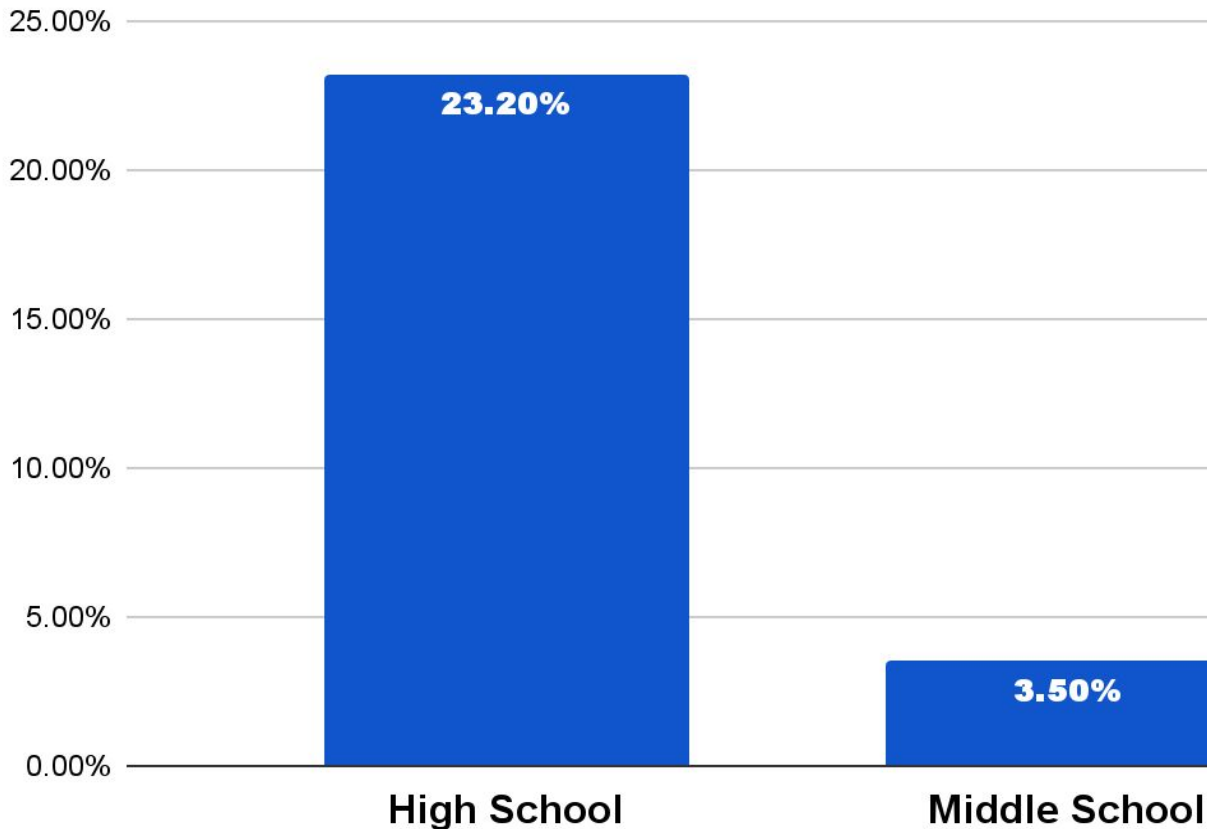
