DISTRICT GOAL: Improve student achievement annually.

 Provide a comprehensive curriculum and instructional program with high standards (PK – 12) which enables all students to improve achievement.

<u>Superintendent's Goal:</u> Increase student performance districtwide annually on TAKS in English Language Arts, Reading, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies.

By 2012:

- Attain or exceed 92% in Reading as measured by TAKS
- Attain or exceed 97% in Writing as measured by TAKS
- Attain or exceed 95% in Social Studies as measured by TAKS
- Attain or exceed 80% in Mathematics as measured by TAKS
- Attain or exceed 75% in Science as measured by TAKS

<u>Superintendent's Goal:</u> Meet or exceed NCLB adequate yearly progress requirements at the District and campus levels.

DISTRICT GOAL: Employ a diverse and qualified teaching, administrative and support staff.

• The district will recruit, employ and retain a quality teaching, administrative, and support staff to attain excellence in student performance.

<u>Superintendent's Goal:</u> Develop a recruitment plan to increase the district's percentage of quality minority staff. Develop a new hire satisfaction survey. The survey will be administered to all new professional employees.

DISTRICT GOAL: Promote safe, healthy, and nurturing schools.

• The district will provide and maintain safe, healthy and nurturing environments conducive to learning, which will enable students to think critically and act responsibly.

<u>Superintendent's Goal:</u> Maintain campus discipline plans that are consistent with the BISD Student Code of Conduct. Develop health-related fitness baseline benchmarks in 2007-2008 that address the physical well being of all students. Identify exemplary safety standards and develop district improvement targets.

DISTRICT GOAL: Efficient use of resources by all district components (campuses, departments and board).

• The district will align its resources with its mission and establish operational processes that systematically improve individual components, which in turn, improve the district. <u>Superintendent's Goal:</u> Achieve the highest rating on the state's financial accountability system (FIRST).
