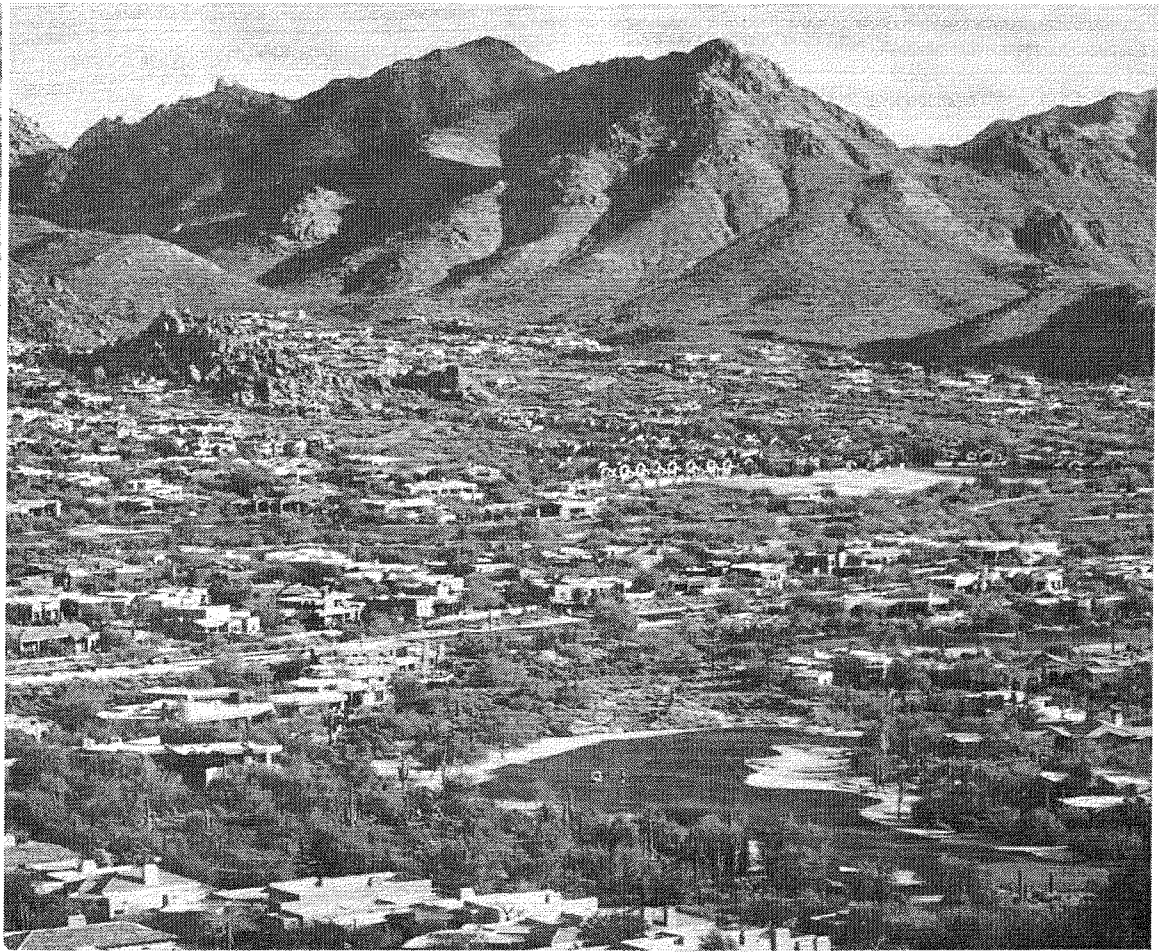
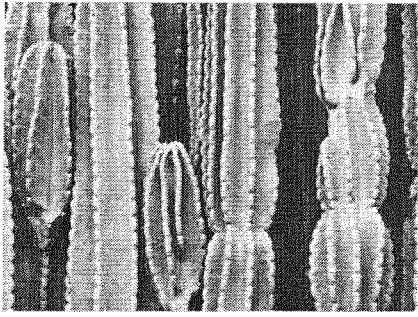

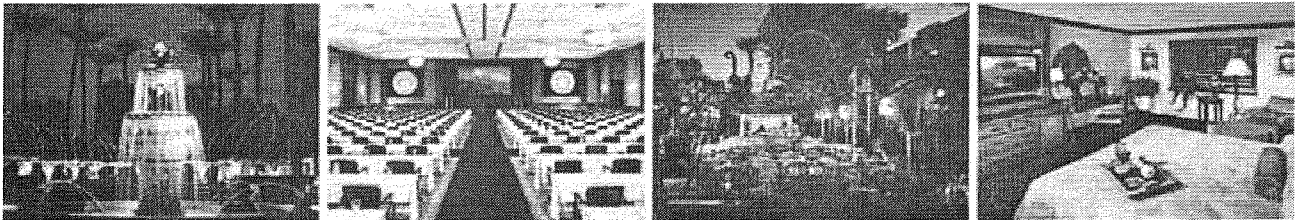

### Session 1: Hands-on Mail Merge

The new Mail Merge 2.0 feature in Synergy 8.0 provides a new way to override existing reports with user-defined Mail Merge 2.0 template documents. This session will show users how to create a Mail Merge 2.0 template document. This session requires an understanding of XML and XPath. Participants will be able to follow along with the instructor on computers in a lab setting with Synergy test environments provided by Edupoint.

### Session 2: Hands-on Workflow

This half day session will instruct participants on how to use the new Workflow feature in a “Hands-On” environment. The session will detail the steps for creating student related workflows, as well as school process workflows. Participants are encouraged to bring sample workflow processes to be used as practice scenarios in this session. Participants will be able to follow along with the instructor on computers in a lab setting with Synergy test environments provided by Edupoint.

## DEVELOPERS TRACK

- 1 Using Existing Web Services**  
Synergy has web services that can be used to extract data, execute reports, and do much, much more. This session will focus on how to engage these web services and provide best practices on how to use them. Attendees should have some basic knowledge of web services. *Level: Advanced*
- 2 SIREN Using ST Query**  
This session will discuss advanced Synergy Query / Reporting techniques and theories. These will include type in query, Query Joins and Syntax, saving as a report, modifying report layouts in SIREN, and aggregation of data – both in Synergy Query and SIREN. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*
- 3 Database Architecture & SQL Query**  
This course will demonstrate how to use SQL scripts to extract a Synergy data dictionary, and walk through Entity Relationship Diagrams (ERDs) of core Synergy database tables. It will also discuss the relationship between database tables and Synergy Business Objects. *Level: Advanced*
- 4 SQL Widgets: Focus on the Student Report Card and Testing Data** ★  
This session will demonstrate how to create and refresh dashboard widgets using either native SQL (with the Synergy database or external data sources) or the Ad-Hoc Query Tool. We will focus on creating graphs of student report card scores and student test results. *Level: Intermediate*
- 5 SIREN Using SQL**  
Using the SIREN report writer, this course will demonstrate how to use native SQL to create and format reports that can be executed in Synergy. Security and best practices will also be discussed. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*
- 6&7 Report Writing with the Synergy Technology Tool Kit (Hands-on Coding)** ★  
The ST Tool Kit gives users the ability to create custom reports with the same tools Edupoint Educational Systems developers use. This session will begin with an introduction of the ST tools used to create reports, and will show how to create a nested databound report. Continuing on, this session will briefly cover ActiveReports layout, ActiveReports code, and developer-driven data loading, and review report implementation strategies. This session is intended for software developers. \*Downloadable material provided prior to the UC. *Level: Advanced*

## IT TRACK

- 1 Database Architecture & SQL Query: An IT Perspective** ★  
This course will focus on Synergy database architecture as it pertains to district IT personnel, such as tips for shrinking large data tables and best practices for database setup, as well as how to use SQL query for data extraction. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced.*
- 2 VMware Setup** ★  
In this session, attendees will learn how to leverage VMWare Cloning to create new or additional Synergy Web or Process Servers. This technique can be used when updating major versions of Synergy to save time and increase the consistency of the Synergy Server configuration. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*
- 3 SQL Server Database Optimization**  
This session will review best practices for SQL server installation and configuration, and discuss options for high availability. We will cover backup as well as server configuration to prevent server performance issues. Session topics include SQL Server backup for database backup, restore and moving data to other SQL servers for disaster recovery, offline data query / extractions, and test / training databases. We will review database table size growth and options to reduce the growth and/or shrink tables. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*
- 4 Security Tips & Techniques**  
This session will discuss the logic Synergy uses to apply security to users. We will also discuss security management, adding users, and security best practices. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*
- 5 Synergy Infrastructure & How it All Works**  
Synergy has many parts in addition to the mandatory web server and database. How do all of these various parts interact with each other? We will discuss the interaction of the database and web server with each other, as well as with process servers, load balancers, LDAP stores, and Generic Conversion. *Level: All*
- 6 Applying Releases, Updates, & Enhancements**  
What is the difference between a versioned release (9.0), a continuous enhancement (CE), and a targeted update (TU)? And how should they be applied to your systems? Learn the intricacies of updating the system and how to ensure your success during the process. *Level: Beginner*
- 7 Third Party Interfaces** ★  
This session will provide an overview of Synergy third-party interfaces, including an understanding of the requirements for integration and data transfer, along with a review how common applications – such as Blackboard, AutoDialer, and more – view and use data within Synergy. Data import/export and tasks using Generic Conversion will also be covered. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*






## SIS 1 TRACK

- 1 Health: Working with Immunization Definitions**  
This session will cover the essentials of entering student health information, creating immunization definitions within Synergy, and executing health reports. Health screen entry, medication and service monitoring setup, and the student health log will also be covered. *Level: Beginner / Intermediate*
- 2 Supporting Synergy**  
Synergy's feature set is vast. How do you support Synergy without being an expert in every area? Learn the philosophy and practice of supporting software, as well as features and tools that make the task easier. *Level: All*
- 3 Discipline & Teacher Referral**  
This session will review the creation of an incident, adding violations, weapons, students and non-students, and creating dispositions for both students and non-students. We will also cover the teacher referral process and how it relates to discipline incidents. *Level: Beginner / Intermediate*
- 4 Scheduling Maintenance & Walk-in Scheduling**  
A scheduler's work is never done. Scheduling during the school year ranges from scheduling a new student using Walk-in Schedule to making individual student changes. This session will review the features of Walk-in Schedule and cover the processes to add, change, and mass assign sections within section maintenance. *Level: Beginner*
- 5 Mass Scheduling & ClassBoard**  
This session will review the setup and process for using Mass Scheduling and ClassBoard. Session topics include School Scheduling Options, creating option sets, running reports, troubleshooting rejected schedules, and finalizing schedules. This session will also review using ClassBoard with Mass Scheduling. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*
- 6 Master Schedule Builder**  
Thinking of using the Master Schedule Builder this year? Master Schedule Builder is a scheduling tool in Synergy that builds the sections in the master schedule. Join this session for an overview of the Master Schedule Builder process, including setup, scheduling and reporting capability. This session is for those that have just started using MSB or are considering using it in the future. *Level: All*
- 7 Course Requests**  
Course Request entry can be a time consuming and tedious task if you don't have the right tools. Join this session to learn how to quickly and efficiently enter course requests using the various options in Synergy. Mass Assign Course Requests and Online Course Requests will be demonstrated. We will also explain the reports and screens available that will enable your scheduling staff to analyze the student requests and transition to the next phase of scheduling with ease. Attendees will leave this session with a better understanding of course request entry and a game plan for the upcoming scheduling season. *Level: Beginner / Intermediate*



## SIS 2 TRACK

- 1 Fees**  
This session will contain a high-level overview of fee setup and how to use the functionality contained in the fees module. Topics to cover will include: Overview and Setup, Assigning Fees, Synchronizing Fees, Entering Fee Payments, Entering Fee Waivers and Refunds, and Viewing Fee and Payment History. *Level: All*
- 2 Grade Reporting**  
This session will review Grading setup, including Mark Definition, the Update Grade process, and Report Card setup and printing. In addition, we will cover GPA Setup, Honor Roll and Eligibility Definition and the Update GPA process and how these definitions reflect on the Student Grade Grid and other reports. *Level: Beginner*
- 3 Student Course History & Graduation Requirements**  
This session will review Course History setup, specifically dealing with Student Transcripts, and the Graduation Requirements. We will also cover basic reports related to Course History. *Level: Beginner*
- 4 Test History: Test Import** ★  
Getting standardized test results into Synergy is critical for tracking student progress. Learn how to use the Test Import functionality to bring results into Student Test for usage throughout the system. *Level: Intermediate*
- 5 Attendance Letters**  
This session will present the basic principles for the creation of Attendance Letters. Step-by-step illustrations will be provided for attendance letters, as well as examples of attendance letters. *Level: Beginner / Intermediate*
- 6 Synergy Mobile Applications** ★  
This course covers an overview of the different mobile applications for Synergy. Topics of how to setup a mobile application to communicate with servers and basic functionality of the applications will be covered. *Level: Beginner*
- 7 New Year Rollover**  
Designed for both Synergy SIS and Synergy SE users, this session will cover processing configuration files for the District and each School, creating attendance calendars, and assigning students to the next grade level and school. This session will also review processing student records from one school year to the next from within the same school, to another school, or multiple schools; assigning year end status; and viewing New Year Rollover process results. *Level: All*



## INSTRUCTION TRACK

- 1 Grade Book & Instructional Data on ParentVUE, StudentVUE, and Mobile Applications**  
This session will review how parents and students use the ParentVUE and StudentVUE applications, and how teachers use Grade Book on mobile applications such as iPad, iPhone, and Android devices. *Level: Beginner*
- 2 LessonVUE, Curriculum, and Instruction**  
This session will review the latest features and functionality of Edupoint's Curriculum/Learning Management System, LessonVUE. Topics will include lesson authoring, videos tied to lessons and standards, LessonVUE and the parent portal (ParentVUE), mapping, pacing, and the Common Core standards. *Level: All*
- 3 New Implementing Districts: Grade Book Implementation & Configuration**  
This session will review implementation, training, and configuration options for newly implementing school districts. Session topics will include grading and scheduling considerations, standards-based grading configuration, report card setup, security considerations, district grade book options, and strategies for successful implementations. *Level: Beginner / Intermediate*
- 4 Grade Book 9.0 and Future Features**   
This session will introduce the new Grade Book features included in the 9.0 release. We will review functionality of new features, the integration of new features with existing functionality, and discuss potential implementation considerations. *Level: All*
- 5 Introduction to TeacherVUE Grade Book**  
This session will provide an overview of the functionality included in TeacherVUE Grade Book. Session topics will include district and teacher configuration options, assignment data collection, grading preferences and options, managing multiple classes, elementary report card processes, secondary report card processes, and standards. *Level: Beginner*
- 6 Standards for Elementary Grade Book**   
This session will review the latest functionality supporting standards-based grading in Elementary Grade Book. Session topics will include district standards, configuring 'Standards' mode and class standards, methods for determining proficiency, report card correlations vs. standards, correlating report card correlations/standards to assignments, capturing standards data, analyzing standards results/creating breakouts based on standards proficiency, and standards-based report cards options, including the new dynamic standards-based report cards. *Level: All*
- 7 Standards for Secondary Grade Book**   
This session will review the latest functionality supporting standards-based grading in Secondary Grade Book. Session topics will include district standards, configuring 'Standards' mode and class standards, methods for determining proficiency, correlating standards to assignments, capturing standards data, analyzing standards results, determining overall grades from standards, and dynamic secondary standards-based progress reports and report cards. *Level: All*

## SPECIAL ED TRACK

- 1 Synergy SE New Features**   
This session will present new features for Synergy SE targeted for version 9.0, as well as a review of major features that have been included in Continuous Updates (CUs) for 8.0, as time allows. Districts that currently use, are in the process of implementing, or may be considering the addition of Synergy SE are invited to attend. *Level: All*
- 2&3 Synergy SE Set-up and Configuration**  
This session will review the setup options available in National Synergy SE. Topics include modifying the Portfolio and utilizing district defined set-up options. Also, learn how to customize many of your Synergy SE documents using Document Definition and Auto Populate. Document security, such as who can delete, print and update Synergy documents, will also be covered. *Level: Beginner / Intermediate*
- 4 Roundtable: From Contract to Go-Live, Synergy SE Implementation Considerations**  
This session will engage participants from currently implementing and recently implemented districts in discussions of successful implementation strategies based on recent experience. General best practices and detailed logistical considerations will be highlighted with the goal of enhancing implementation effectiveness. *Level: All*
- 5 Roundtable: We're Live, Now What? First Year(s) Synergy SE Support Considerations**   
This session will engage participants from recently implemented districts in discussions of successful post-adoption strategies based on recent experience. General best practices and detailed logistical considerations will be highlighted with the goal of maximizing end user product competence and product acceptance. *Level: All*
- 6 User-defined Tabs, Fields, and Reports within Synergy SE**  
This session will present the basic principles for creation of user-defined data within Synergy SE. Step-by-step illustrations will be provided for the addition of a tab to the Synergy SE student view, with examples of custom data reporting capabilities. *Level: All*
- 7 HANDS-ON: Synergy SE Query**  
This course will actively involve the participants in expanding the capabilities of the basic Synergy Special Education query. This includes adding additional data, changing titles, changing column size, ordering, sorting, and grouping data in order to create a professional looking report. Participants will learn how to specify conditions in order to filter out unwanted data and how to allow others to easily take advantage of queries by creating reports and scheduling report distribution. Participants will be able to follow along with the instructor on computers in a lab setting with Synergy test environments provided by Edupoint. *Level: Intermediate*

The rules engine in Synergy allows a district to implement custom validation for data entry such as enrolling students, changing student data, and creating health alerts. This session will focus on how to configure these rules, and will also go over best practices. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*
- 3 Security Tips & Techniques**  
This session will discuss the logic Synergy uses to apply security to users. We will also discuss security management, adding users, and security best practices. *Level: Intermediate / Advanced*
- 4 HANDS-ON: User-defined Data - Customizing Existing Screens**  
This session will instruct participants on how to customize existing Synergy screens in a "Hands-On" environment. 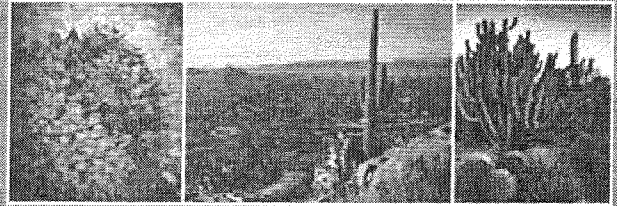
