Browning Public Schools Policy #4130 Policy Name: Instructional Field Trips Requiring Transportation and Food Service Accommodations Regulation-----The Board recognizes that field trips, when used as a device for teaching and learning integral to the curriculum, are an educationally sound and important ingredient in the instructional program of the schools. Such trips can supplement and enrich classroom instruction by providing learning experiences in an environment beyond the classroom. The Board also recognizes that field trips may result in lost learning opportunities in missed classes. Therefore, the Board endorses the use of field trips when the educational objective achieved by the trip clearly outweighs any lost in-class learning opportunities. Field trips which take students out of the state must be approved in advance by the Board of Trustees. Field trip activities must be integrated with the curriculum, coordinated with classroom activities, and be consistent with the District's Strategic Plan.
