BLACKFEET HOLD A 'VICTORY DANCE'

BROWNING, Nov. 16.—(AP)—Blackfeet Indian tribesmen held a victory dance here last night, in celebration of their official approval yesterday of the Wheeler-Howard bill, providing the tribe with self-government in the matter of economic affairs.

The election was polled at Browning, Heart Butte, Old Agency, Little Badger, Seville and Babbs. The total vote cast was 1,041, out of 1,489 eligible electors.

The ballot showed an 18-to-1 approval of the bill for the charter of self-government. Of the total vote cast, only 60 were in opposition.

The next step will be the election of a council, to be done within the next 30 days. The group will be incorporated under the name of the Blackfeet Indian Business council.
