TOPIC: Approval of Computer Purchase through State Grant

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District purchase 219 Dell Optiplex 7010 computers with 22" monitors from Dell Marketing, LP, for a total purchase price of \$156,171.09.

RATIONALE:

The State of Michigan provided Section 22i funding for the purchase of equipment for districts to become technology ready for online assessments and any where, any time, any place, any pace learning. These computers will be placed into the secondary library media centers to create an additional classroom set of computers to be used for online assessments and student learning. The recommendation has been reviewed and supported by the Board Finance Committee.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

This purchase will be charged to the Section 22i Technology Infrastructure fund. The State of Michigan provided \$10 per student, for a total of \$156,200, which was placed into this fund.
