

## **TOWN OF HORIZON CITY**

**A RESOLUTION ORDERING AN ELECTION BY THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF HORIZON CITY, TEXAS ON MAY 3, 2025 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR PLACES 1, 2, 4, AND 6 FOR FOUR-YEAR TERMS AND A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE SAME DATE TO FILL THE VACANCY IN PLACE 5 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM EXPIRING IN MAY OF 2027.**

**WHEREAS,** the Charter of the Town of Horizon City provides that general elections for Council Members are held on the May uniform election date;

**WHEREAS,** the terms of Council Members in Places 1, 2, 4, and 6 will expire, and those positions must be filled for four-year terms;

**WHEREAS,** the general election date established by this Resolution shall be held on May 3, 2025 which is the May uniform election date;

**WHEREAS,** a vacancy has occurred in Place 5 with the resignation of the Council Member currently occupying the seat, and it is necessary fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term which will expire in May of 2027;

**WHEREAS,** upon election, the terms of office for Places 1, 2, 4, and 6 will be for four (4) years, and the term for Place 5 shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HORIZON CITY:**

### **SECTION I.**

That in compliance and accordance with the laws and constitution of the State of Texas, an election shall be and the same is hereby called and ordered for May 3, 2025 for the purpose of electing four (4) Council Members for Places 1, 2, 4, and 6 for terms of four (4) years each; and one (1) Council Member for Place 5 to fill the remainder of the unexpired term.

### **SECTION II.**

The City Clerk, together with the El Paso County Elections Administrator, shall prepare the official ballot for said election. The ballot shall designate the Places for Council Members as Places 1, 2, 4, 5, and 6, respectively.

### **SECTION III.**

That no person's name shall be placed upon the official ballot as a candidate for the position unless such person has filed a sworn application, in compliance with the laws of Texas, no sooner than January 15, 2025 nor after February 14, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. The designation of the Place the candidate is seeking must appear on the face of the application.

#### **SECTION IV.**

That the polls shall be kept open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election, and at such election, all qualified voters in the Town are authorized to vote for his or her choice of candidate for each place and shall vote for one candidate only for each place, with the due return being made to the Council showing the number of votes cast for each candidate for each of the positions of Council Members.

#### **SECTION V.**

That Lisa Wise, County Elections Administrator, shall be the early voting clerk for said election. The County Courthouse, 500 E. San Antonio, El Paso, Texas, is hereby designated as the main early voting polling place for said election. In addition, early voting may also occur at such branch early voting polling places as are designed herein or otherwise designated by the El Paso County Elections Administrator and for which notice is given, and early voting on Saturday and Sunday is ordered. The City Clerk is authorized to revise or add exhibits to this Resolution and to the Order of Election designating these early voting locations and times for voting as are established or revised by the El Paso County Elections Administrator.

Applications for ballot by mail shall be submitted to the Early Voting Clerk: 500 E. San Antonio, Lower Level, Ste. L1 15, El Paso, TX 79901, no later than the close of regular business in the Early Voting Clerk's office, or 12 noon, whichever is later on the **11th day** before the date of the Election or as may otherwise be required by law.

#### **SECTION VI.**

That a candidate who receives a majority of all of the votes cast for the office for which he or she is a candidate shall be elected for such office. In the event of a tie, the provisions of Section 2.002 of the Texas Election Code, or other applicable state statute dealing with a "Tie Vote," shall be followed. If a runoff election is required to elect an officer by a majority vote, it shall be held on a date as permitted by the Texas Election Code. Such election, if any, shall be called by the City Council. Early voting dates and sites will be identified if such runoff election shall be held.

**SECTION VII.**

That electronic voting machines, as certified for use by the El Paso County Elections Administrator, shall be used for voting at the regular polling places in such election, and for the casting of early ballots by persons voting early by personal appearance.

**SECTION VIII.**

That this Resolution, signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk, shall constitute the proclamation of the Mayor calling and ordering said election, and that the City Clerk is directed to prepare the appropriate notice of election containing the directives of this Resolution and the Order of Election, as required by the Texas Election Code. The City Clerk shall give notice of such election in English and Spanish by posting such notice at the Town Hall and by publishing a copy of such notice in a newspaper as required by law.

**SECTION IX.**

The City Clerk shall deliver notice of this election to the County Clerk and Voter Registrar of El Paso County as required by law, not later than February 14, 2025.

**SECTION X.**

That the polling places for this election, except as they may be changed by the City Council of Horizon City, Texas, shall be as follows:
