At the June 13, 2024, State Board of Education meeting, the Prairie Grove School District's boundary change petition under Arkansas Code § 6-13-1414 was presented. At that time, the State Board tabled resolution of the petition, pending collaboration between the districts on the issue of transportation. The State Board said that it would revisit the petition at its next meeting. At its July 11, 2024, meeting, the State Board heard a progress report from the Department on the status of the districts' resolution and moved to again table the issue pending the districts' collaboration. This matter will be heard at the next State Board meeting. The meeting will be on September 12, 2024, beginning at 9:00 a.m. As this boundary change petition affects the Lincoln School District, please have representatives from your district available to answer any questions the State Board might have.
