Background	The large equipment at DES and CMS is approximately 15-20 years old and has exceeded its anticipated life expectancy. The associated cost of repairs exceeds the return on investment. Below is a description of the equipment being replaced by campus: <ul style="list-style-type: none">DES: Convection Steamer (qty 1), Reach-In-Cooler and Reach-In-Warmer (qty 1 ea.). \$57,074.94CMS: Roll-In Heated Warming Unit (qty 1), Mobile Proofer Cabinet (qty 1), and Roll-In Racks (qty 3). \$28,709.25
