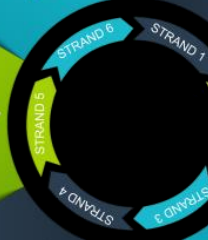
Digital Learning

School library programs promote reading as an essential skill for learning, personal growth, and enjoyment which are essential skills for college, career, and community.



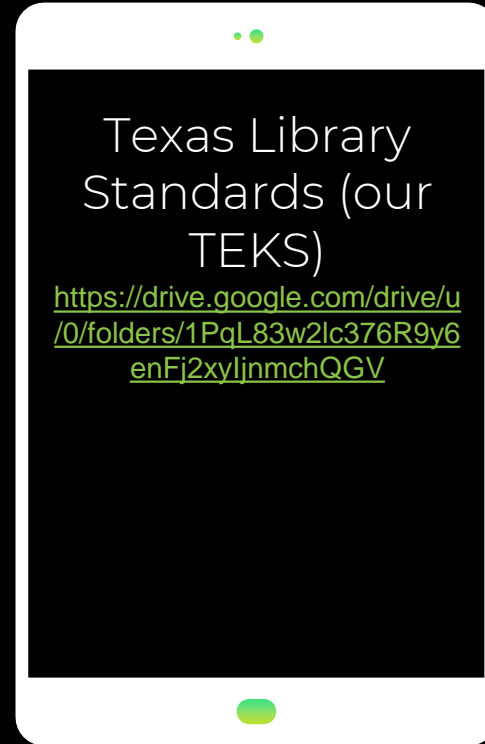
