1. State Report Card Data

Dr. Michelle Erb presented the school report card data, focusing on key assessments, graduation rates. She explains the changes in the cut scores and the impact on proficiency levels in ELA, math and science. She also highlighted the importance of chronic absenteeism and the need for targeted interventions to address it. Dr. Erb discussed the District's efforts to improve math proficiency through professional development and curriculum changes.

The building principals shared the efforts and the challenges they are working through. The high school shared positive growth in graduation rate. While other building mentioned the challenges of maintaining a high rating of the five essentials survey and the importance of staff morale and supporting each other.

2. New courses for FY27

Jake Hubert introduces six new courses that will be added to the course catalog for next school year. This includes animation, diversity in education, geometry for construction and design, introduction to cyber security, culinary three and construction three and four. Jake explained the rationale behind each new course and the expected impact on the students' career pathways. He mentioned that the potential for students in construction courses to work with Habitat for Humanity and other community organizations.

The redesign of the course catalog has pictures and more color to make it more updated. The new catalog is available in digital format which will allow students and their families to read it in their language. Counselors will have the paper version.
