

- Increase the percentage of students at Northside scoring Meets on the Math STAAR from 29% to 39%.





STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above All Grades, ELA/Reading




STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above All Grades, Mathematics



STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above All Grades, Science




STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above All Grades, Social Studies
