





#### STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above All Grades, ELA/Reading




#### STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above All Grades, Mathematics



#### STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above All Grades, Science




#### STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above All Grades, Social Studies
