## Math

Students were assessed on STARMath in September. We utilized our technology to test all one grade in a day and the next day the other grade. This turned out good and it cut down on the testing window time frame.

#### enVision math

For September all the second and third students were assessed in enVision math on the math placement test. Second grade was assessed with the end of the year 1<sup>st</sup> grade test and third grade was assessed with the end of the year 2<sup>nd</sup> grade test. This allows teachers to see what skills students struggle with and how they will need differentiate their lessons to address these skills.

## **Reading Block**

Reading Blocks have begun September 12. We have 15 classes on grade level for reading. This is a testament to the hard work 1<sup>st</sup> grade and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade did last year! We have 8 classes that are not on grade level; 2-SPED (which teach the alternate core), 1-3<sup>rd</sup> grade, and 5-2<sup>nd</sup> grade classes. We tested ISIP similar to STARMath, one grade level per day and it worked out ok once we got it all up and running. A total of 333 second and third grade students assessed on ISIP
