

Consider approval of Communities in Schools of San Antonio for the 2025-2026 school year.

1. Background:

Communities in Schools of San Antonio (CIS-SA) provides counseling and supportive guidance to at-risk students at our two comprehensive high schools and our four middle schools. These services are supplemented by comprehensive case management. Case management services will encompass health and social services, parent and family involvement, educational and academic support, pre-employment skills training, and cultural activities.

2. Process:

The CIS-SA program will serve at-risk students at Southwest High School, Southwest Legacy High School, McAuliffe Middle School, McNair Middle School, Resnik Middle School, and Scobee Middle School. CIS site coordinators will identify at-risk students who are referred by campus administrators, counselors, social workers, or other campus staff. Students enrolled with CIS receive counseling, supportive guidance, and case management services.

3. Fiscal Impact:

The cost of the CIS program will not exceed \$162,750.20 and will begin on August 1, 2025 and will end on July 31, 2026.

4. Recommendation:

That the board approve the 2025-2026 contract with Communities in Schools of San Antonio (CIS-SA).
