

4.0510.04 GRADES 9-12 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Thirty-six (36) units of credit from a list of courses approved by the Board of Education and the State Board of Education are required for graduation by DCSD schools, including:

1. Language Arts – four credits (plus required labs)
2. Mathematics – three credits (plus required labs) for graduation; ~~four credits (plus required labs) for graduation~~; four credits (plus required labs) for college-ready
3. Science – three credits
4. Social studies – three and one-half credits (beginning with the graduating class of ~~2027~~)
5. Arts – one and one-half credits
6. Healthy and Physical Education – two credits
7. Career and Technical Education – one credit
8. Digital Studies – one-half credit
9. General Financial Literacy – one-half credit
10. Electives – as many as needed to reach 36 total credits

Selected elective units of credit provide a means of specialization related to student interest and post-secondary goals.

The District may modify a student's graduation requirements to meet the unique educational needs of the student if the student has a disability and the modifications to graduation requirements are made through the student's IEP.
