### FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Community Members,

This annual report card issued by the Oregon Department of Education shows an overview of what Sheridan AllPrep Academy offers.

During the 2015-2016 school year, we made significant gains in three areas: graduation rate, dropout rate, and freshman on track. Our graduation rate increased by 16%. While we are still trying to reach even higher goals, this improvement is noteworthy. Our dropout rate, previously at 40%, went down to 16.4% due to strengthened ties with our students and families. Finally, our rate of freshmen on track to graduate increased from 16.7% to 70% in one year. While we recognize that we

still have many improvements to make, we are pleased with our incremental progress.

We will continue to support our students' growth and celebrate their individual successes. Families can best support students by providing help at home, coaching students, and communicating with teachers. Together, we will create the best learning environment for our students.


