The levy adoption is a four-step process:

- 1. Presentation of Tentative Levy (October 27, 2015)
- 2. Adoption of Tentative Levy (November 9, 2015)
- 3. Presentation of Final Levy (December 1, 2015)
- 4. Adoption of Final Levy (December 15, 2015)

Between presentation of Final levy and adoption, there is the publication of the Truth-In taxation notice (which will be in Wednesday Journal of December 2, 2015). This is a requirement if the school district is going to adopt a levy in excess of 5%; however, District 97 has always chosen to publish this notice, to be fully transparent and communicative to its stakeholders, even though it has never, in the eight years I have been here, adopted a levy in excess of 5%.

For 2015, the overall operating levy increase is proposed at 1.31% and, in terms of all funds (including debt), the proposed levy increase is only 0.50%.

On December 15, 2015, a Public Hearing will be conducted and it is anticipated the Board will approve the proposed final levy. Following approval, I will hand-carry the paperwork which is attached for formal filing with the Cook County Clerk.
