District Improvement Plan Highlight for 2022-2023

The following is a summary of the highlights of the District Improvement Plan for the 2022-2023 school year:

- ESSER II funding will be utilized by the District to implement activities that are necessary to continue the employment of existing staff.
- ESSER III funding will be used to:
 - Provide supplemental after school programs at Gilbert;
 - Provide summer school for all students;
 - Refresh current educational technology for students and staff;
 - Provide ongoing TBRI training for teachers in order to expand mental health support for students;
 - Provide MTSS Behavior training and support to general education behavior teachers;
 - Provide Reading Academy stipends for teachers completing the training;
 - Upgrade the District's custodial services to meet new health guidelines;
 - Hire additional MTSS/RtI teachers to address learning loss;
 - Hire new MTSS Behavior teachers to address behavioral needs;
 - Hire an additional Student Support Counselor to expand mental health support for students; and
 - Hire an instructional assistant for Learning Lab support at HJH.
- Review and revise the Strategic Plan.
- Provide trauma-informed training for new teachers and administrators.
- Weekly door audits will be conducted at each campus for every outside door.
- The Guardian Program will be implemented in the 2022-2023 school year.
- SISD will conduct a Security Audit during the 2022-2023 school year.
- Expand RBL Grant and Personalized Instruction Strategies throughout the district.
- Investigate ways to move employee and student records to a digital format.
