- The data being reported in the 2022-23 Annual Report are not new, but it is the only place that compiles all of the data.









All Grades, All Subjects - STAAR 3 - 8 & EOC




State, Region, District Comparison




STAAR 3 - 8 and EOC




All Grades, All Subjects - Bilingual/ESL




