 - a. CRES Devices
 - i. How do we want to proceed with iPads?
 1. Other brands of tablets currently don't support OSMO. OSMO is a priority of the district K-2.

 1. Chromebooks purchase for grade 3 and Ipads moved down to K-2. Chromebook cart model.
