I recommend approving the Resolution to Conduct a Referendum Election in 2013. This does not commit the school district to conducting an operating referendum this fall. I am not recommending that the school board approve an operating referendum at this meeting. Rather, this resolution permits the board to review the information pertinent to an operating referendum in July and make a decision at that time. Without the resolution, the school board would not have the option to consider an operating referendum at the July meeting.
