AGENDA ITEM: District of Innovation Update

Background Information:

As was discussed at the September 17, 2018 board meeting, the District would pursue District of Innovation (DOI) status in an effort to improve the way that students are served, as determined by local needs. The flexibilities available with DOI status can include exemptions from some state mandates related to student attendance, decision-making processes, academic calendar, and teacher appraisals, for example. A large number of Texas school districts have made the decision to become Districts of Innovation.

As prescribed by state law, at Texas Education Code, Chapter 12A, the board approved the adoption of a DOI resolution, held the public hearing on becoming a DOI, and appointed a DOI committee at the October board meeting.

Since the October board meeting, the following meetings have occurred as follows:

- October 18th the Bearcat Leadership Team (BLT) participated in the research of no less than 75 DOI districts and possible exemptions
- October 23rd the District-Wide Effectiveness Improvement (DWEIC)/District of Innovation (DOI) committee met and completed the same research activity as the BLT
- From October 24th through October 29th, DWEIC members shared the DOI information with their campus staffs and requested all staff provide feedback on a Google form
- October 30th the DWEIC/DOI Committee reviewed all feedback to date. At this
 meeting consensus was reached to bring forth the following draft exemption

 The four proposed exemptions will be posted as a draft plan on the DOI website for 30 calendar days beginning November 13th.

Administrative Considerations:

- All information about the Aledo ISD DOI process will be available to the community on a DOI webpage on the district's website. The draft DOI plan will be posted on the webpage and all feedback from the community will be reviewed by the DWEIC/DOI committee and shared with the Board of Trustees prior to the committee's recommendation of a final plan for the Board's consideration.
- The adoption of a DOI plan by the Board will necessitate some revisions to Board policies.
- Proposed timeline is as follows:

Mid-November/December:

November 12th board meeting: Board reviews draft DOI plan.

November 13th through December 12th proposed plan is posted on the district website to request stakeholder feedback – must be posted for 30 days.

December 12th DOI committee meets to review all the stakeholder feedback on the proposed plan.

December 17th the latest version of the DOI plan is shared at the December board meeting.

January:

January 9th – DOI committee meets to vote on the proposed DOI plan. Send notification to the Commissioner of our intention to vote on local DOI plan. January 22nd board meeting, the board conducts first reading of the DOI plan as approved by the DOI committee.

February:

February 19th board meeting, board has second reading and votes to approve/not approve DOI plan – must be 2/3 majority.

February 20th administrative staff will notify the Commissioner of Aledo ISD Board approval and the list of exemptions, and the approved plan will be sent to TEA within 15 days of adoption (by March 8th).

We will post the approved plan online with all other DOI documents.
