**ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S):** Financial/Facilities – The District shall exhibit excellence in financial and facility planning, management, and stewardship.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- In 2011, the Texas Legislature enacted Senate Bill 18 regarding the use of eminent domain authority by governmental entities in the State of Texas.
- Senate Bill 18 made a number of procedural and substantive changes in the law of eminent domain in Texas.
- Senate Bill 18 added a new section in the Texas Government Code, Section 2206.101. Subsection (b) of that statute provides that any entity, including private entities, authorized by the state by a general or special law to exercise the power of eminent domain, must submit, not later than December 31, 2012, a letter to the Comptroller of Public Accounts stating the entity is authorized by the state to exercise the power of eminent domain and identify each provision of law that grants the entity that authority.
- The letter must be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested. If the entity does not submit the letter by that deadline, the entity's power of eminent domain expires on September 1, 2013.

### ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATIONS:

- Although the District's Administrative Staff is not aware of a situation where eminent domain has been utilized by the Aledo ISD, it would not be prudent to disregard the requirements in Senate Bill 18 and limit the District's ability to do so in the future if warranted.
- Therefore, the following form titled Required Documentation of Eminent Domain Authority in Texas will be completed and presented to the Board of Trustees during the November board meeting for consideration of approval.

# Required Documentation of Eminent Domain Authority in Texas

What action must be taken: Per Senate Bill 18 enacted by the 82nd Legislature, all public and private entities authorized to exercise the power of eminent domain in Texas are required to submit a letter to the Comptroller of Public Accounts detailing their legal authority to exercise this power. The letter must be sent by certified, return receipt mail not later than December 31, 2012. (Per the bill, the authority of an entity to exercise the power of eminent domain expires on September 1, 2013, unless the letter has been submitted by the deadline.)

**About this form:** This form is designed to guide entities in submitting the required information on eminent domain authority. Once the fields have been completed, the form can be printed and mailed via certified, return receipt to the address provided to meet the requirements of the bill.
