

SAMPLE POLICY

COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES

Students who have satisfactorily completed all coursework requirements for graduation but have failed to meet applicable exit-level testing requirements shall be allowed to participate in commencement activities and ceremonies upon compliance with remediation and retesting requirements outlined in this policy. [See EI, EIF]

REMEDICATION AND RETESTING REQUIREMENTS

A student who fails to meet the passing standard on any portion of applicable state-mandated exit-level or end-of-course assessments by the end of grade 11 shall enroll in, attend, and participate in the remediation summer school session and the summer retest session, as well as in all applicable remediation courses, tutoring programs, and retesting opportunities throughout the grade 12 school year until the student has met all applicable exit-level and end-of-course testing requirements.

Except as provided by law, no student shall be allowed to participate in commencement activities and ceremonies without meeting the applicable coursework requirements and either:

1. The applicable exit-level and end-of-course testing requirements; or
2. The remediation and retesting requirements outlined in this policy.
