# **Registration #'s Update**

- 228 registrants so far in 2025 (& more registered for upcoming classes)
- 318 total registrants since the program launched in Fall 2024

  - Did this program meet your expectations and desired outcomes?
    - (Answer: 1-5 range, 1 = No & 5 = Yes)
    - **95% answered a 4 or 5** (*Improved from Fall 2024 Classes: 92%*)
  - Did you learn something new from this program or benefit from having registered for this program?
    - 98% said Yes (Only 1 No Again)
  - I am also receiving some qualitative feedback through the evaluation surveys which I share with instructors to improve future classes, along with the quantitative data.

#### • Social Media Campaign for Upcoming Classes

I have a list that helps me to stay organized with this, so I am keeping up with posts to get more registrations - it has been working! I also hang up flyers in the school halls and around town at local businesses for classes, and I have the schools share my posts digitally on their screens and parent newsletters when relevant for those age groups!
