

Grant Report
January 2018

We received the grant from the **Crossett Foundation** for \$20,000 for the purchase of musical instruments at all the schools. I budgeted for guitars, ukuleles, mandolins, and several different sizes of guitars as well as racks to hang them on the wall. We are very grateful to the Crossett Foundation that has funded many projects for us in the past. They ask that if we have any publicity about the project to please include where the funding came from. The district is starting to plan now for Jason Norris and Stella Lyn to come back to the district in the fall.

As a result of the **Pre-elementary grant** from the state for \$50,000, we have started groups one day a week for 3-5 year olds in Thorne Bay and Naukati. Korrisa Oatman is doing a great job as the project leader and is receiving guidance from Tracy Gunkel in Thorne Bay and Maggie Gore in Nauakti.

Since the last grant report we also submitted for a USDA Farm to School grant for \$50,000 for two years. We will not know until May and not holding our breath on this one as it is very competitive. We have also submitted for several small grants, some in the amount of \$1000 and one for \$3500.

We have now received our carryover funds in the federal programs and revised the budgets. These amounts were \$12,831 in Title I, \$8327 in Title II, and \$3000 in Carl Perkins.
