EVALUATE THE CURRENT STATE OF YOUR FACILITIES

The best way to develop a master plan is to first understand the condition and needs of existing facilities. The process starts with ICAT listening to and learning about the district's vision, challenges and opportunities.

HOW ICAT SERVES YOUR DISTRICT

ICAT assembles a team to conduct a comprehensive field evaluation of facilities that identifies the physical and functional needs of each building. The assessment identifies deficiencies in mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems, roof and other exterior conditions plus code and ADA accessibility. The findings are used to create time and cost scenarios for renovating at your existing site or building a new school on another property.

Districts benefit from an impartial evaluation that determines project costs and priorities. The assessment builds consensus and creates an action plan. The ICAT team stays engaged to help facilitate the next steps to keep the process moving.

DISCOVER

DEFINE

- Determine selection criteria based on district needs
- Identify potential design teams
- Develop and distribute Request for Qualifications (RFQ) if applicable
- Reply to questions and report interest to the district

DETERMINE

- Customize evaluation tools with weighted criteria for scoring and ranking
- Facilitate the RFQ review process and assist in determining a short list, if needed, for interviews
- Schedule and facilitate design team interviews
- Moderate post-interview discussion
- Assist the committee to finalize selection and inform all design teams

SECURING COMMUNITY SUPPORT

Engage with the community to pass your bond referendum on the first attempt. Districts have only one opportunity annually to take the request to voters, so there is no time to waste with failed attempts.

HOW ICAT SERVES YOUR DISTRICT

ICAT assists districts during public forums by listening and answering the community's project questions. The proposed projects, preliminary budget, and timeline are presented to the community to educate voters on the need and the tax impact, if any. Voters typically have similar concerns to a bond referendum, and ICAT provides answers to help the district overcome obstacles and secure community support.
