**SUBJECT:** Schoolcraft College Millage Proposal

Under state law, community colleges that wish to call an election to ask for a local property tax millage must have their local school district constituents file for the election with the county clerk.

This is in no way a recommendation or position on the millage proposal, it is merely a statutory procedural requirement in order for a community college to get such a proposal on the ballot. We have previously reviewed this with our legal counsel at Thrun Law and they concur that this is a requirement for local school districts.

The proposed resolution is attached for discussion during the Committee of the Whole meeting of July 23, 2018. This item will also be on the agenda of the July 23<sup>rd</sup> regular meeting for a vote.
