Background Information:

- SB 294 allows schools to implement policy regarding medication for respiratory distress.

Administrative Considerations:

- This collaborative agreement with The University of North Texas Health Science Center will provide Keller ISD with access to the Asthma 411 program.
- Asthma 411 provides a range of resources including:
 - Access to rescue medication for students having trouble breathing through a consulting physician and standing orders for albuterol.
 - Asthma education tools for children and families, professional development for school nurses, and tools to build awareness for staff.
- Rapid intervention for students experiencing symptoms of respiratory distress can result in improved student health, attendance, and achievement.
