CURRICULUM

During the 2020-21 school year, the district adopted multiple core programs K-12 which will begin implementation at the start of the 2021-22 school year. Some of these programs were purchased for implementation during the 20-21 school year, but due to COVID it was difficult to consider them as having a year's implementation. It is critical to consider this coming year as *YEAR 1 IMPLEMENTATION* for each of the following programs. Implementing a new instructional program can take up to three years to ensure proper training for instructional staff, monitoring student outcomes, as well as annually reviewing the curriculum for strengths/weaknesses. Implementing the programs below will include; professional development for staff in August, on-going training and follow-up support throughout the year, as well as continued monitoring by myself, instructional coaches, and building principals to ensure staff and student success!

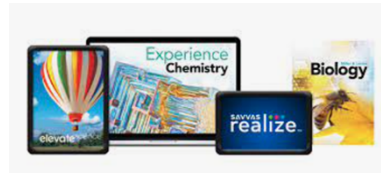

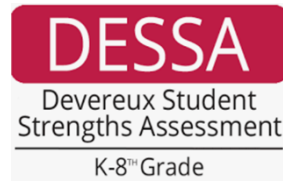
