Why sustainability, climate and environmental justice? Challenges we will face in the 21st century.

- Historically unprecedented warming globally and in Illinois will continue throughout this century.
- Flooding, heat waves, droughts, and other extreme weather events, will become more frequent and intense.
- Communities of color and other marginalized groups will face the worst consequences of climate change.
- Most young people are "extremely worried" about climate change.



Why sustainability, climate and environmental justice? Our choices will greatly impact the intensity and impacts of climate change.

- D97 has a responsibility to minimize its environmental footprint.
- In age appropriate ways, D97 students should learn:
 - the causes and effects of climate change.
 - how future choices will matter and the important roles they can play in addressing climate change.
- Our students should be prepared to participate in the rapidly growing green economy.

- Strong statement of vision and purpose
 - Global and local crises we face
 - Our responsibility as a district to address our footprint
 - Our responsibilities to our students/student-centered approach.
- Establish Sustainability Task Force, members include:
 - D97 point person
 - Students
 - Staff
 - Board members
 - Community members incl. parents, experts
 - Engagement consistent with Policy 7:12 Equity



D97 Policy - Sustainability, Climate and Environmental Justice. *Policy Framework*

- Sustainability plan process
 - Developed w/in one year of task force formation.
 - Opportunities for broad community engagement.
 - Collaborate with other local institutions.
 - Collaborate with relevant Board committees.
 - Apply racial equity impact assessment to plan.
 - Annual report to Board and community progress, proposed modifications, etc.



D97 Policy - Sustainability, Climate and Environmental Justice. *Policy Framework*

- Sustainability plan contents
 - Meet science-based greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction goals.
 - Decrease footprint in areas such as energy, waste, procurement (including food), and facilities.
 - Provide student learning opportunities and curriculum consistent with policy goals.
 - Achieve cost-savings through energy savings, external funding, etc. while considering budget implications of possible actions
 - Develop assessment framework credible, clear, publicly accessible
