#### **INNOVATIONS:**

- 1. The new technology lab is OPEN! Our staff is working to build a schedule that will allow class time this year so that students can participate in the new learning environment. Teachers will be piloting some new technologies so that we can make definite plans for implementation of a technology lab time that will be scheduled daily next school year. While in the lab teachers can target intervention and advanced learning plans for students.
- 2. Pre-K Staff will begin working on creating new grading reports for the 2016 2017 school year. New Pre-K Guidelines have been released and will require updates to our current report card.

## **CAMPUS NEWS:**

1. Through math interventions and specific targeted lessons math assessment scores have continued to increase. Currently we have 1 students working below 59% on math assessment averages!!!!! Everyone else in kindergarten is working at 60% and above! Student that were targeted for intervention have gained an average of +23 points on the assessment average!

- 2. We have been given approval for the High Quality Pre-K Grant.
  - a. We are working to create a job description for a parent liaison / behavior interventionist that will serve students, families, and teachers as students transition into school!!!!!
