Re: Originality of Work Tool

The district determined there was a need for a software tool that checks a student's written work against electronic texts from the Internet, published works (such as journal articles and books), and assignments previously submitted by other students. As a result, the district issued an RFP on February 28, 2022, to select a company to provide a solution for monitoring and prevention of plagiarism in grades 6-12. The district received two compliant responses.

An evaluation committee composed of representatives from both campus and central administration departments was assembled to evaluate those responses to establish the best value. The resulting tabulation of those evaluations provided the following suppliers, in ranked order.

- 1. Turnitin, LLC
- 2. Copyleaks

District administration will attempt to negotiate a successful contract with the first ranked vendor, and if unsuccessful, we will move to the next ranked vendor.

The district administration intends to use ESSER funds to cover the cost of this service for at least the first year of the award.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approves the administration to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the recommended suppliers, renewed annually, not to exceed approximately \$45,000 Annually, as long as the service continues to meet the needs of the District.
