County. The program offers coaching, training, and access to comp	etitive
debate events in formats such as World Schools, Lincoln-Douglas, F	olicy,
and Congressional Debate.

Staffing	The program's central mission is to expand access to debate education, strengthen students' critical thinking, public speaking, teamwork, and leadership skills, and create pathways to higher education. Over the years, CASE Debates has grown to serve more schools and students than originally projected, demonstrating its impact and continued commitment to empowering youth through academic competition and enrichment. Crosby ISD must provide a minimum of one program coach.

Budget Information	The approval of the Interlocal Agreement with Harris County Department of Education will provide an amount not to exceed \$2,500.00 for Crosby ISD's CASE Debates program coach at Crosby High School.
Impact of this Action	Approval of this action will allow students attending Crosby High School access to participate in local and state-level debates, fostering critical thinking, academic confidence, and strong communication skills. Participation in CASE Debates also enhances college and career readiness by strengthening research abilities, collaboration, and civic engagement. In addition, involvement in a structured, competitive debate program elevates the district's academic profile, provides equitable enrichment opportunities for all students, and supports the development of future leaders who are prepared to advocate, problem-solve, and excel beyond high school.
