Lakes Area Youth Service Bureau:

In partnership with the LAYSB, Community Education provides opportunities for youth to gain leadership skills and give back to their community through participation on the Youth Advisory Board. YAB members have worked on projects including a Battle of the Bands and promoting Tobacco Free Parks. This summer they are planning "days of service" at Feed My Starving Children and helping with the Living on Less Resource Fair for Families.

Partnerships with Castlewood and Tanners Brook Golf Courses allow Community Education to offer a variety of recreational and competitive golf leagues and clinics for teens.
