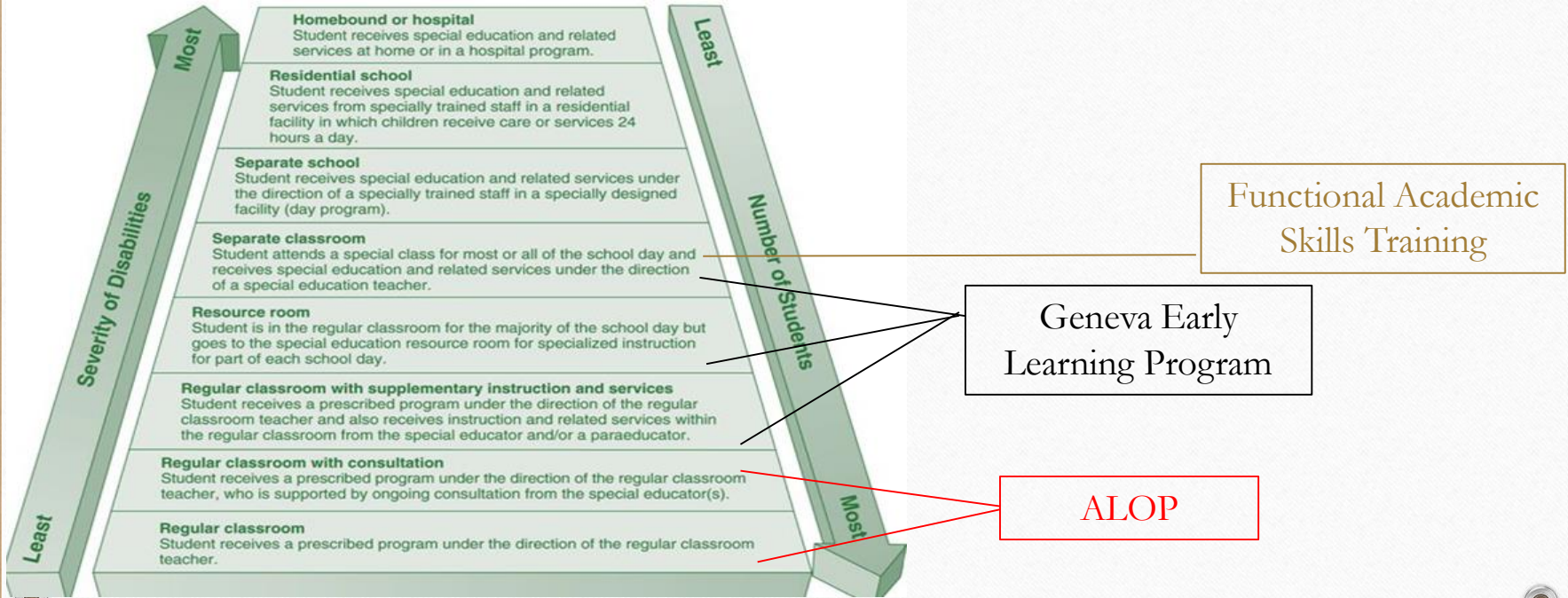

The continuum of services identifies different service delivery models to provide specially designed instruction to a student eligible for special education services.

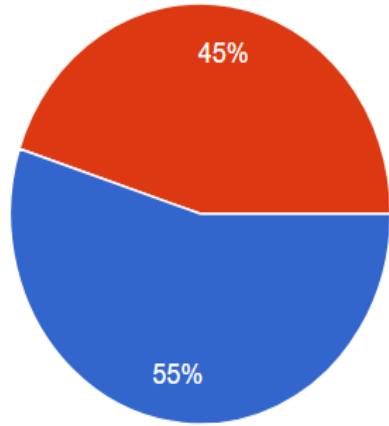

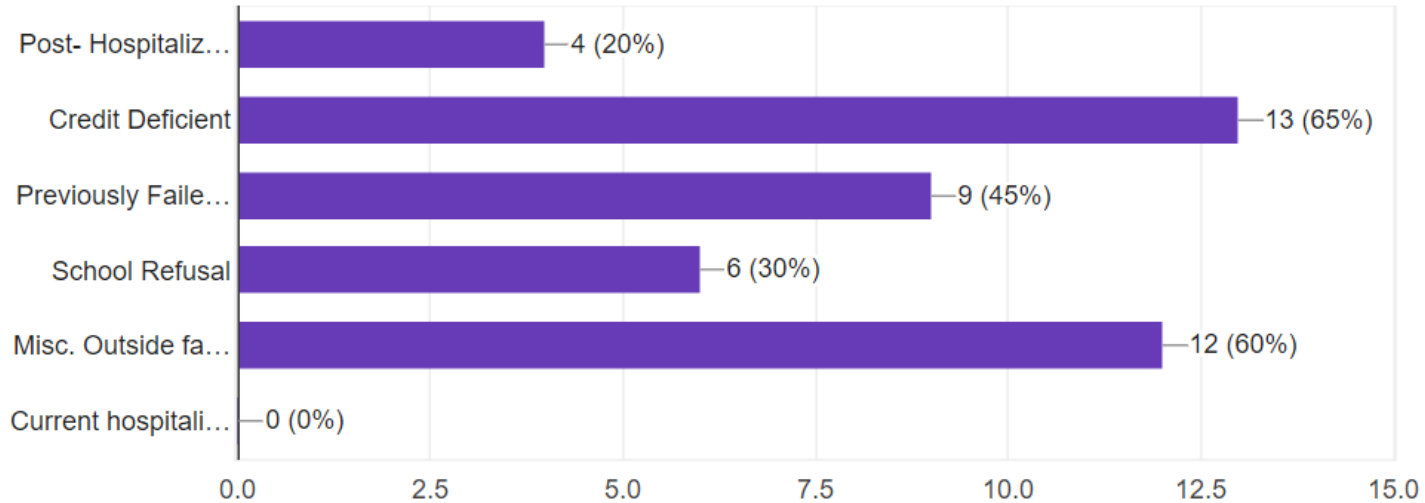

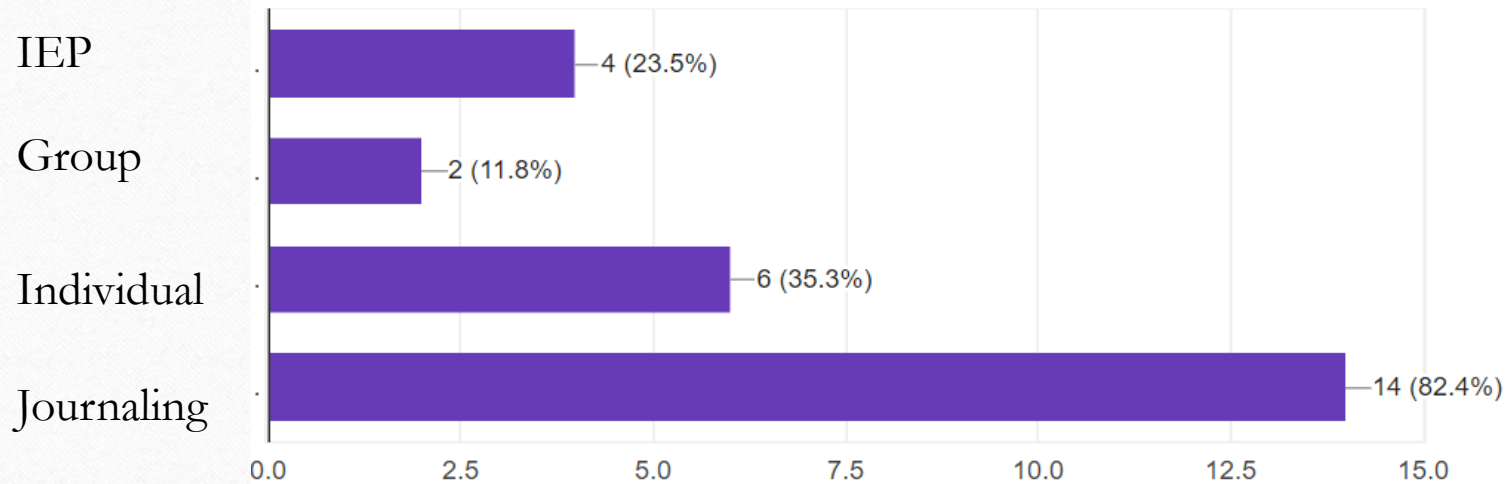
# REASON FOR ALOP REFERRAL



# STUDENT CHARACTERISTICS

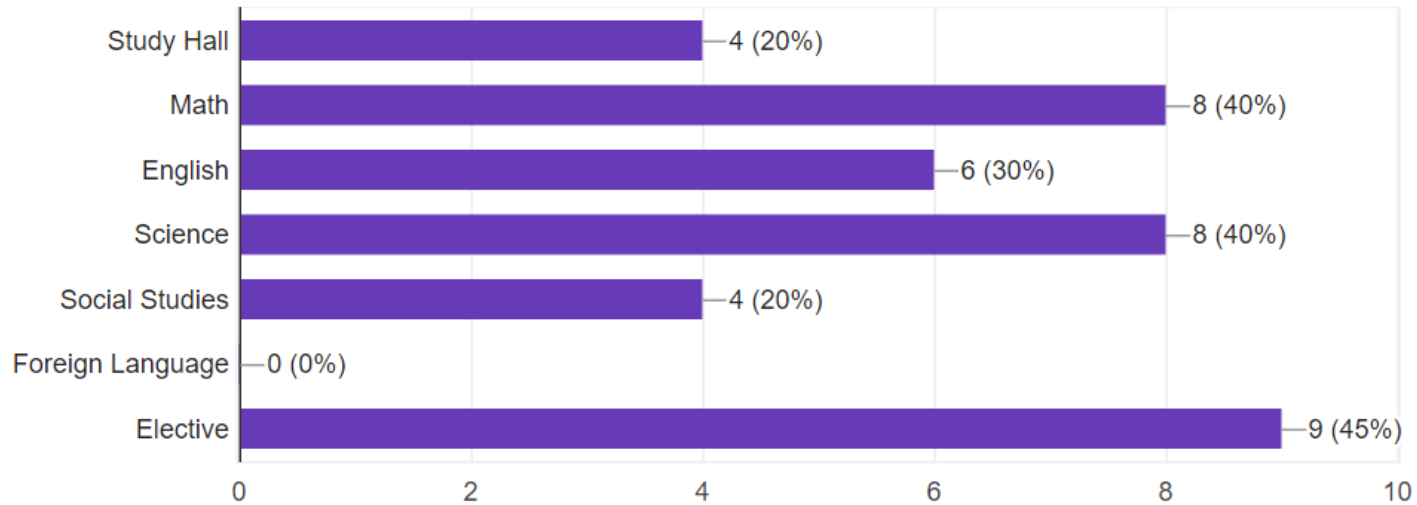

# MOVING FORWARD

- Write District 304 ALOP grant
- Work independently of Mid-Valley Special Education Cooperative
- Utilize reimbursement for additional services to support students – Social Work, Special Education, etc.
- Collaborate with outside agencies to provide targeted interventions to support students

# Functional Academic Skills Training

Housed at Geneva Middle School South

# CURRENT PROGRAM

Students receive instruction from a special education teacher, outside of the regular education environment, for four periods of the day.

- Language Arts (2 periods)
- Math
- Life Skills (in lieu of Social Studies)

Students receive instruction within the regular education classroom with support for four periods of the day.

- PE
- Science
- Exploratory Classes
- Study Hall

# PROGRAM ENHANCEMENTS for 2018-19

- Provide students the opportunity to be instructed by a special education teacher in the content areas of Science and Social Studies.
- Add a vocational component to the program.
- Provide students enhanced opportunities related to independent living skills.
