Failure to comply with this requirement may be penalized by the Board of Directors. In addition, IHSA By-law 2.130 requires each member school principal or his/her designee shall be in attendance at an annual principals' rules meeting/town meeting conducted in November. A complete listing of the Town Meetings/Principals Rules Meetings can be found on the IHSA website. Also, please review the information provided regarding the Rocky Clark Catastrophic Insurance legislation in the State of Illinois which requires high schools in Illinois to provide catastrophic insurance coverage for students participating in IHSA sanctioned athletic events. Publications for the 2018-19 school term will be shipped the first week of August.
