## **Background Information:**

A CFA (Community Facilities Agreement) is a document required by the City of Fort
Worth to bind the development of a new site with required public improvements. This
includes water, sewer, drainage and road improvements.

## **Administrative Considerations:**

- The CFA for this site includes water/sewer extension, offsite and onsite drainage systems, and new street sections on Keller Hicks Road.
- The water/sewer portion of the CFA is needed to complete the site infrastructure and to provide fire protection for vertical construction.
- KISD is allowed to do public work using our CM at Risk contractor in lieu of the City contracting the project. This gives the district control of cost and timing.
- Change Order #1 will incorporate the water/sewer public improvements into our current Guaranteed Maximum Price. The cost of this work is \$694,812.00 and complies with our budget.
