

CCMR Indicators in Aledo ISD

<u>Meet criteria of 3 or higher on at least 1</u> <u>AP exam</u>

Students who take AP classes typically take the test in May. This test is scored between a 1-5. Students who score a 3 or above are CCMR met. Students can see their scores in their College Board account.

<u>Be eligible for college credit in an</u> <u>OnRamps course</u>

AHS students are ELIGIBLE for college credit through an OnRamps course are CCMR met. This does NOT mean that they accept the college credit. Just that they earned a D or higher in the college portion of the course.

OnRamps options: Algebra, Pre-Calc, US History, English/Rhetoric, Physics, Chemistry, Economics

<u>Complete a program of study in CTE and</u> earn an industry-based certification (IBC)

Currently, Aledo ISD CTE offers 11 programs of study that have an IBC. These include Ag Animal Science, Ag Mech/Welding, Ag Plant Science, Business, Computer Science, Commerical Photography, Cosmetology, Education & Training, Graphic Design, Health Science, News Production/Yearbook. Students will need to have completed multiple courses in the pathway and pass an IBC that aligns with the pathway.

<u>Successful completion of Texas College</u> <u>Bridge/College Prep English/Math course</u>

These courses will be offered to SENIORS who have not yet demonstrated college readiness in English and/or Math. These courses are designed to help strengthen your skills to get your ready for college/career. Successful completion may also waive the required TSIA2 placement exam and allow you to start taking college-credit courses immediately following high school!

Enlist in the Armed Forces or Texas National Guard.

There will be a process that a student will follow with their high school counselor to verify enlistment.

<u>Complete a dual credit course(s). (9 hours in</u> <u>ANY subject OR 3 hours in English/Math)</u>

AHS students who pass Engl 1301 or Engl 2322 through Weatherford College earn their 3 hours and are CCMR met. AHS students who take and pass ANY 3 dual credit classes through WC over the course of high school are also CCMR met. Courses we offer: Psychology, Speech, Gov't, Econ, Huma.

Earn a Level 1 or Level 2 Certificate

AHS students who take and complete coursework, program hour requirements and exams in Cosmetology or Welding are eligible for a Level 1 certificate.

<u>Meet TSI-A 2 criteria via SAT/ACT/TSIA2</u>

<u>exams</u> SAT: 1010 Total with at least a 480 on EBRW and 530 in Math

ACT: Composite score of 23 with at least a 19 in Math and 19 in Reading

TSI-A2: ELAR 945 and 5 or higher on essay Math 950

Graduate with completed IEP and Workforce Readiness or Graduate Under an Advanced Diploma Plan

*These options are for Special Education students.
