NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ADOPTION OF THE BRISCOE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

The Board of Trustees of Silverton ISD will conduct a public hearing before considering final adoption of the recently completed 2025 Briscoe County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update on DATE at the Silverton High School located at 700 Loretta St. Silverton, Texas. This plan includes mitigation actions intended to minimize the impacts of certain natural hazards on the residents of the County.

The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as amended, requires that local governments develop, adopt, and update natural hazard mitigation plans in order to receive certain federal assistance. A Mitigation Action Team (MAT) comprised of representatives from Briscoe County, City of Quitaque, City of Silverton, Silverton ISD, and Turkey-Quitaque ISD, was convened to assess the risks from and vulnerabilities to natural hazards that are endemic to the Briscoe County area, and to make recommendations on mitigating the effects of such hazards. The former hazard mitigation plan was adopted in 2018, and should be updated with FEMA at least every five (5) years.
