**SB 9:** Senate Bill 9 (SB 9) of the 87th Texas Legislative Session requires school districts to offer curriculum to students in *the prevention of child abuse* (elementary & secondary), *family violence* (elementary & secondary), *dating violence* (secondary), and *human/sex trafficking* (secondary).
