



LCISD UIL Home School Participation Procedures and Guidelines 2025-26

- Home School Participation is permitted in any UIL sanctioned Athletic Activity.
- Non-enrolled students should register by the start of school for activities.
- Non-enrolled students will be expected to abide by UIL and LCISD guidelines, policies, and procedures.
- Non-enrolled students will be required to provide proof of academic eligibility every 3 weeks.
- Non-enrolled students will provide their own transportation to their designated athletic period and practices. They will be expected to ride LCISD transportation to and from games they are participating in.
- Home school participation is based on the residency of the parents and can only participate in the attendance zone determined by the residence. Residency must be established for a full calendar year to be varsity eligible per UIL policies.
- If an LCISD student unenrolls to attend Home School, they will not be eligible for participation for a calendar year from the withdrawal date.
- Once a non-enrolled student has been accepted, they must be continuously enrolled to participate in UIL Athletic Activities.
- Home School Participants may compete in UIL athletic activities, but other school sponsored events are limited to full-time enrolled students.

Step 1 – Office of Student Programs

Complete the Non-Enrolled (Home School) registration form from the Office of Student Programs and complete the online new student registration forms in skyward. The Office of Student Programs will determine the home campus where the student is allowed to participate.

Items Required:

- Completed registration form.
- Birth Certificate
- Address Verification Documents (Utility Bill, Lease/Rental Agreement, Mortgage Statement)
- Verification on residence for previous year (for varsity participation only)
- Vaccination Record (consistent with current LCISD policies)
- Standardized Test verifying grade level placement. (Iowa Test of Basic Skills, Stanford Achievement Test, or California Achievement Test). Must demonstrate the required academic proficiency by achieving a composite, core, or survey score that is within the average or higher than average as established by the applicable testing service. LCISD will accept testing results from any certified third-party testing center.

The Office of Student Programs will notify the campus registrar and the parents in writing that the application has been submitted and approved, and the non-enrolled student is ready for registration.

Step 2 – Campus Registration

The Office of Student Programs will notify the Campus Registrar that the non-enrolled student is ready for registration. The registrar will meet with the family and enroll the non-enrolled student as a “zero-member” because they will be attending school for less than 2 hours a day in conjunction with the school period designated to the participants school period (PEIMS/Campus Registrar). Campus Registrar will go through the registration process setting the non-enrolled student up with a school ID# and a school badge.

Step 3 – UIL Compliance Coordinator

There will be an orientation to welcome non-enrolled students and parents and walk them through UIL and LCISD policies, procedures, and guidelines.

Step 4 – Campus Administrator

Designated Campus Administrator will guide the non-enrolled student through the process of checking into the school for the athletic period and checking out to return home. They will advise on the process of entering the school as well as the designated times for picking up and dropping off of participants during the school day. Students and parents will be given the opportunity to ask questions and clarify this process. This is essential for campus safety and campus safety audits.

Step 5 – CAC, ACAC, Campus Head Coaches

This will include an introduction to UIL and LCISD policies and procedures for participation at that campus. All non-enrolled students must go through the Varsity Previous Athletic Participation form to gain eligibility. Varsity eligibility could be determined at the District Executive Committee level. Students participating in Athletics must complete the required Rank One Forms (Current Physical and Medical History, Consent to Treat, UIL and LCISD Forms, Bonafide Residence Form) prior to participation in Athletics. The non-enrolled student and parent will receive campus-based participation information at this level.

2025-26 LCISD UIL Home School Participation

- Home School Participation is permitted in any UIL sanctioned Athletic Activities
- Home school participation is based on the residency of the parents and can only participate in the attendance zone that the residence is zoned for. Residency must be established for a full calendar year to be varsity eligible per UIL policies.
- Non-enrolled Students should register by the start of school for activities.
- Non-enrolled students will be expected to abide by UIL and LCISD guidelines, policies, and procedures.
- Non-enrolled students must provide standard grade level proficiency testing for enrollment.
- Non-enrolled students will be provided with a student ID and a badge. Student identification must be always worn on campus.
- Non-enrolled Students will be required to provide proof of academic eligibility every 3 weeks.
- Non-enrolled students will be expected to participate in the UIL event class period as well as any practice involved in preparation for competitions and events.
- Non-enrolled Students will provide their own transportation to their designated athletic period and practices. They will be expected to ride LCISD transportation to and from games they are participating in, unless coaches allow participants to be signed out at contests and events.
- Non-enrolled students may not participate in additional Homeschool leagues at any time. Non-enrolled students must refrain from additional lessons and/or coaching during regular school hours. Participation during the school day outside of LCISD school instruction will result in the student being disqualified from competition and possibly resulting in team penalties such as forfeitures.
- If an LCISD student unenrolls to attend Home School, they will not be eligible for participation for a calendar year from the withdrawal date.
- Non-enrolled Participants may compete in UIL athletic activities, but other school sponsored events are limited to full time enrolled students.
