The Tupelo Public School District Consolidated Federal Program application includes the financial school wide support for grades pre-kindergarten through 2 based on final allocation approval.

The following are the recommendations for the 2011-2012 consolidated federal programs application:

TITLE I: Basic

Methods used to determine eligibility of program schools will be the 35% rule and Grade Span Grouping (K-2).

- The Early Childhood Education Center will offer classes that include transportation based on funding.
- Building level coaches
- The Early Literacy resources, technology and training for each PK-2 elementary school will continue.
- Support services for English as Second Language students and their parents will continue to be provided.
- Parent involvement services will continue to expand.
- Professional Development within the district as well as out of district will include training resulting from curriculum development needs with a focus on the Common Core Standards
- Funding for the local Neglected/Delinquent facilities will be provided as allocated.
