Geneva Community Unit School District 304 Teacher Induction Program 2011/2012

I. Summer Orientation (half-day)

Information meeting for teachers new to District 304 held prior to the beginning of the school year (June, July and August). Topics include compensation procedures, employee benefits (e.g. health, dental, and life insurance, flexible spending plans, 403b tax-sheltered annuity program), personal and sick leave, Board of Education policies, an orientation to the District's technology resources, and completion of employment-related paperwork.

II. Staff Connections Website (www.geneva304.org/staffconnections)

A website with useful information about District programs, procedures, and people.

III. New Teacher Institute (two full days; one half-day)

Held the week prior to the beginning of the school year, two and a half days devoted to introducing new teachers to the history and tradition of the school district, administrative and support staff, school district curriculum, student health protocols, and building practices and procedures.

IV. New Teacher Mentoring

A teacher new to District 304 is paired with an experienced teacher who offers practical and timely perspective and support during the school year.

V. Building Orientation

Orientation activities sponsored by individual buildings throughout the school year helping to foster socialization and the integration of new staff in the building.

VI. Information Sessions (after school)

After school sessions offered throughout the school year focusing on the Geneva Professional Teaching Standards. A schedule of meeting dates and times will be distributed at the beginning of the school year.

VII. Instructional Coaching

Focused and constructive feedback on instructional performance offered by a veteran teacher to staff members new to the District.
