Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?

North Valley Football Coaches looks to gain School Board approval for a trip to WaterWorks Park in Redding, CA. The trip would act as a reward and culminating event for our players attending football camp. The date of the trip would be Monday, June 18th. We have already secured a discounted group rate with WaterWorks Park - \$16.00/player for admission and a meal. These fees would be covered by players and the football program. We would leave in the morning on the 18th and return in the late evening on the 18th. Van-Certified coaches and faculty will be the drivers and chaperones on the excursion. School district vans are already reserved.

Provide history/background information on your proposal:

Traditionally, the North Valley Football Team attends an out-of-area residence camp during the summer. This summer, due to military changes with Camp Rilea (camp), we will not be attending. Instead, we will do a two-day mini-clinic at Grants Pass HS. Camp Rilea offered a great opportunity for our boys to see another area of the state, and for some, their first glimpse of the Pacific Ocean. We lose that staying in town for camp, so the WaterWorks trip offers a reward and incentive for our kids to attend camp. In addition, it provides us with a great opportunity for team building activities, which are an integral component of our program.

List the advantages of your proposal:

1. Allows our kids an incentive-based trip many of them would not have outside of football
2. Provides our players with important time, outside the football field, to build relationships and strengthen bonds
3. Gives our kids a cheaper, closer, and more time-friendly football camp experience alternative
