Youth Enrichment:

Youth Recreation:

- Youth wrestling wrapped up on February 15th. It was a great season!
- Beginner and Junior Hoops ended on February 10: 91 total participants preschool 3rd grade.
- Junior Hoops boys and girls had the opportunity to play during a halftime at either the boys or girls' game. That was very entertaining to watch and fun to see our future basketball players!
- Sunday Open Gym from 1-3 pm. This has been quite popular this winter with an average of 30-40 people coming.
