MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

House Bill 2598—Amending References to School Psychologists

Effective date: September 1, 2025.

This bill replaces the term *licensed specialist in school psychology* with the term *school psychologist* in the Texas Education Code, the Texas Government Code, and The Texas Occupations Code. The definition of *school psychologist* is a person who holds a license to engage in the practice of psychology under Texas Occupations Code section 501.260.

SENATE BILL 646—LOAN REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE FOR MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

Effective date: September 1, 2025.

This bill expands the definition of *mental health professional* to include a licensed master social worker, a person who holds a licensed professional counselor associate license, a licensed marriage and family therapist associate, and a school counselor certified under Chapter 21 with a master's degree related to counseling. This bill creates eligibility requirements for a mental health professional's loan repayment assistance if the person meets certain criteria. One path for a mental health professional to be eligible for repayment assistance is to provide mental health services to students enrolled in a Texas public school for one to three consecutive years. This bill increases the amount of repayment assistance available to mental health professionals. The amount of repayment assistance now ranges from \$15,000 to \$180,000, depending on the mental health profession.

THECB may use appropriated funds to market repayment assistance for mental health professionals to students in post-secondary institutions, mental health professionals, and professional associations and organizations.

SENATE BILL 1401—MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSION PIPELINE

Effective date: September 1, 2025.

This bill requires THECB to establish the Texas Mental Health Profession Pipeline Program and to encourage the development of other programs for community college students to have a clear path to degrees in certain mental health professions upon transferring to a participating institution. Available baccalaureate and post-baccalaureate degrees or certificates in this program would lead to license and practice as a psychologist, a licensed professional counselor, an advanced practice registered nurse with certification in psychiatric or mental health nursing, a master social worker or clinical social worker, a licensed specialist in school psychology, or a marriage and family therapist.
